Bible Verses About Healing - The Bible speaks often of miraculous healing through the work of Jesus Christ and through faith in God. Find Scripture that will encourage you and help you focus on finding comfort through the healing of Christ both spiritually and physically.

- **Proverbs 4:20-22**

My son, pay attention to what I say; listen closely to my words. Do not let them out of your sight, keep them within your heart; for they are life to those who find them and health to a man's whole body.

- **Exodus 15:26**

He said, "If you listen carefully to the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in his eyes, if you pay attention to his commands and keep all his decrees, I will not bring on you any of the diseases I brought on the Egyptians, for I am the LORD, who heals you."

- **Psalms 107:19-21**

Then they cried to the LORD in their trouble, and he saved them from their distress. He sent forth his word and healed them; he rescued them from the grave. Let them give thanks to the LORD for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for men.

- **Exodus 23:25**

Worship the LORD your God, and his blessing will be on your food and water. I will take away sickness from among you,

- **Psalms 30:2**

O LORD my God, I called to you for help and you healed me.

- **Isaiah 53:4-5**

Surely he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.

- **Psalm 103:2-4**

Praise the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits-- who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion,

- **Psalm 41:2-3**

The LORD will protect him and preserve his life; he will bless him in the land and not surrender him to the desire of his foes. The LORD will sustain him on his sickbed and restore him from his bed of illness.

- **Psalm 147:3**

He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

- **Jeremiah 17:14**

Heal me, O LORD, and I will be healed; save me and I will be saved, for you are the one I praise.

- **Matthew 8:5-17**

When Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to him, asking for help. "Lord," he said, "my servant lies at home paralyzed and in terrible suffering." Jesus said to him, "I will go and heal him." The centurion replied, "Lord, I do not deserve to have you come under my roof. But just say the word, and my servant will be healed. For I myself am a man under authority, with

soldiers under me. I tell this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and that one, 'Come,' and he comes. I say to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it." When Jesus heard this, he was astonished and said to those following him, "I tell you the truth, I have not found anyone in Israel with such great faith. I say to you that many will come from the east and the west, and will take their places at the feast with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven. But the subjects of the kingdom will be thrown outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth." Then Jesus said to the centurion, "Go! It will be done just as you believed it would." And his servant was healed at that very hour. When Jesus came into Peter's house, he saw Peter's mother-in-law lying in bed with a fever. He touched her hand and the fever left her, and she got up and began to wait on him. When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to him, and he drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick. This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: "He took up our infirmities and carried our diseases."

- **Matthew 9:35**

Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness.

- **Mark 5:34**

He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering."

- **Luke 8:43-48**

And a woman was there who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years, but no one could heal her. She came up behind him and touched the edge of his cloak, and immediately her bleeding stopped. "Who touched me?" Jesus asked. When they all denied it, Peter said, "Master, the people are crowding and pressing against you." But Jesus said, "Someone touched me; I know that power has gone out from me." Then the woman, seeing that she could not go unnoticed, came trembling and fell at his feet. In the presence of all the people, she told why she had touched him and how she had been instantly

healed. Then he said to her, "Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace."

- **Luke 8:49-56**

While Jesus was still speaking, someone came from the house of Jairus, the synagogue ruler. "Your daughter is dead," he said. "Don't bother the teacher any more." Hearing this, Jesus said to Jairus, "Don't be afraid; just believe, and she will be healed." When he arrived at the house of Jairus, he did not let anyone go in with him except Peter, John and James, and the child's father and mother. Meanwhile, all the people were wailing and mourning for her. "Stop wailing," Jesus said. "She is not dead but asleep." They laughed at him, knowing that she was dead. But he took her by the hand and said, "My child, get up!" Her spirit returned, and at once she stood up. Then Jesus told them to give her something to eat. Her parents were astonished, but he ordered them not to tell anyone what had happened.

- **Revelation 21:4**

He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away."

- **James 5:16**

Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective.

- **1 Peter 2:24**

He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds you have been healed.

Isaiah 41:10 - Fear thou not; for I [am] with thee: be not dismayed; for I [am] thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.

Jeremiah 17:14 - Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou [art] my praise.

1 Peter 2:24 - Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

Isaiah 53:5 - But he [was] wounded for our transgressions, [he was] bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace [was] upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

Jeremiah 33:6 - Behold, I will bring it health and cure, and I will cure them, and will reveal unto them the abundance of peace and truth.

Psalms 103:2-4 - Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:

James 5:14 - Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

James 5:15 - And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Matthew 10:1 - And when he had called unto [him] his twelve disciples, he gave them power [against] unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.

James 5:16 - Confess [your] faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

3 John 1:2 - Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

Philippians 4:19 - But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Matthew 10:8 - Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely

ye have received, freely give.

Proverbs 17:22 - A merry heart doeth good [like] a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones.

Psalms 127:3 - Lo, children [are] an heritage of the LORD: [and] the fruit of the womb [is his] reward.

Deuteronomy 7:15 - And the LORD will take away from thee all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which thou knowest, upon thee; but will lay them upon all [them] that hate thee.

Romans 5:3-4 - And not only [so], but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience;

Hebrews 11:6 - But without faith [it is] impossible to please [him]: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and [that] he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Isaiah 54:17 - No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue [that] shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This [is] the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness [is] of me, saith the LORD.

Proverbs 16:24 - Pleasant words [are as] an honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.

Matthew 11:28 - Come unto me, all [ye] that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

Proverbs 4:20-22 - My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings.

James 4:7 - Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Isaiah 57:18 - I have seen his ways, and will heal him: I will lead him also, and restore comforts unto him and to his mourners.

Hebrews 11:1 - Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

2 Corinthians 12:9 - And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

John 10:10 - The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have [it] more abundantly.

Luke 4:18 - The Spirit of the Lord [is] upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

Matthew 7:1-29 - Judge not, that ye be not judged.

Psalms 34:20 - He keepeth all his bones: not one of them is broken.

Psalms 6:2 - Have mercy upon me, O LORD; for I [am] weak: O LORD, heal me; for my bones are vexed.

Deuteronomy 32:39 - See now that I, [even] I, [am] he, and [there is] no god with me: I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I heal: neither [is there any] that can deliver out of my hand.

Hebrews 13:8 - Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

Romans 12:2 - And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what [is] that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Romans 12:1-2 - I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, [which is] your reasonable service.

Numbers 6:25-27 - The LORD make his face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee:

1 Corinthians 11:1-34 - Be ye followers of me, even as I also [am] of Christ.

Luke 10:9 - And heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.

Matthew 13:58 - And he did not many mighty works there because of their unbelief.

Matthew 28:1-20 - In the end of the sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first [day] of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre.

Matthew 9:27 - And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed him,

crying, and saying, [Thou] Son of David, have mercy on us.

Matthew 4:23 - And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.

Jeremiah 30:17 - For I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the LORD; because they called thee an Outcast, [saying], This [is] Zion, whom no man seeketh after.

Isaiah 57:18-19 - I have seen his ways, and will heal him: I will lead him also, and restore comforts unto him and to his mourners.

Psalms 51:1-19 - (To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David, when Nathan the prophet came unto him, after he had gone in to Bathsheba.) Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy loving kindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions.

Psalms 41:4 - I said, LORD, be merciful unto me: heal my soul; for I have sinned against thee.

Numbers 12:13 - And Moses cried unto the LORD, saying, Heal her now, O God, I beseech thee.

James 5:11 - Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender mercy.

Acts 28:27 - For the heart of this people is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes have they closed; lest they should see with [their] eyes, and hear with [their] ears, and understand with [their] heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them.

Acts 4:30 - By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.

Acts 4:21-22 - So when they had further threatened them, they let them go, finding nothing how they might punish them, because of the people: for all [men] glorified God for that which was done.

Luke 5:17 - And it came to pass on a certain day, as he was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of

Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and the power of the Lord was [present] to heal them.

Matthew 17:20 - And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.

Matthew 13:15 - For this people's heart is waxed gross, and [their] ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes they have closed; lest at any time they should see with [their] eyes, and hear with [their] ears, and should understand with [their] heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them.

Ecclesiastes 3:1-3 - To every [thing there is] a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven:

Job 5:17-18 - Behold, happy [is] the man whom God correcteth: therefore despise not thou the chastening of the Almighty:

1 Peter 2:21-24 - For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:

Ephesians 4:1-32 - I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called,

2 Corinthians 7:1 - Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

2 Corinthians 5:7 - (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)

2 Corinthians 1:3 - Blessed [be] God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort;

1 Corinthians 12:9 - To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;

Acts 10:38 - How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

John 14:27 - Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

John 12:40 - He hath blinded their eyes, and hardened their heart; that they should not see with [their] eyes, nor understand with [their] heart, and be converted, and I should heal them.

Luke 7:7 - Wherefore neither thought I myself worthy to come unto thee: but say in a word, and my servant shall be healed.

Mark 1:30-31 - But Simon's wife's mother lay sick of a fever, and anon they tell him of her. Read more of Mark.

Isaiah 57:19 - I create the fruit of the lips; Peace, peace to [him that is] far off, and to [him that is] near, saith the LORD; and I will heal him.

Isaiah 19:22 - And the LORD shall smite Egypt: he shall smite and heal [it]: and they shall return [even] to the LORD, and he shall be intreated of them, and shall heal them.

Ecclesiastes 3:11 - He hath made every [thing] beautiful in his time: also he hath set the world in their heart, so that no man can find out the work that God maketh from the beginning to the end.

Psalms 119:77 - Let thy tender mercies come unto me, that I may live: for thy law [is] my delight.

Psalms 119:71 - [It is] good for me that I have been afflicted; that I might learn thy statutes.

Psalms 119:50 - This [is] my comfort in my affliction: for thy word hath quickened me.

Psalms 119:40 - Behold, I have longed after thy precepts: quicken me in thy righteousness.

Psalms 119:28 - My soul melteth for heaviness: strengthen thou me according unto thy word.

Psalms 119:25 - DALETH. My soul cleaveth unto the dust: quicken thou me according to thy word.

Psalms 107:41 - Yet setteth he the poor on high from affliction, and maketh [him] families like a flock.

Psalms 103:1-5 - ([A Psalm] of David.) Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, [bless] his holy name.

Psalms 41:3 - The LORD will strengthen him upon the bed of languishing: thou wilt make all his bed in his sickness.

Psalms 41:1-3 - (To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David.) Blessed [is] he that considereth the poor: the LORD will deliver him in time of trouble.

Psalms 35:27 - Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favor my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.

Psalms 34:6 - This poor man cried, and the LORD heard [him], and saved him out of all his troubles.

Job 5:26 - Thou shalt come to [thy] grave in a full age, like as a shock of corn cometh in in his season.

2 Chronicles 7:14 - If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

2 Kings 20:8-9 - And Hezekiah said unto Isaiah, What [shall be] the sign that the LORD will heal me, and that I shall go up into the house of the LORD the third day?

1 Samuel 12:16 - Now therefore stand and see this great thing, which the LORD will do before your eyes.

Deuteronomy 32:36 - For the LORD shall judge his people, and repent himself for his servants, when he seeth that [their] power is gone, and [there is] none shut up, or left.

Ephesians 2:2 - Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:

Galatians 3:14 - That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

1 Corinthians 11:1-5 - Be ye followers of me, even as I also [am] of Christ.

Romans 4:17 - (As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before

him whom he believed, [even] God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were.

Acts 4:16 - Saying, What shall we do to these men? for that indeed a notable miracle hath been done by them [is] manifest to all them that dwell in Jerusalem; and we cannot deny [it].

Acts 4:10 - Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, [even] by him doth this man stand here before you whole.

Acts 2:41-43 - Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added [unto them] about three thousand souls.

John 4:47 - When he heard that Jesus was come out of Judaea into Galilee, he went unto him, and besought him that he would come down, and heal his son: for he was at the point of death.

Luke 14:4 - And they held their peace. And he took [him], and healed him, and let him go;

Luke 13:13 - And he laid [his] hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

Luke 13:12 - And when Jesus saw her, he called [her to him], and said unto her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity.

Luke 10:19-20 - Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Luke 8:48 - And he said unto her, Daughter, be of good comfort: thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace.
